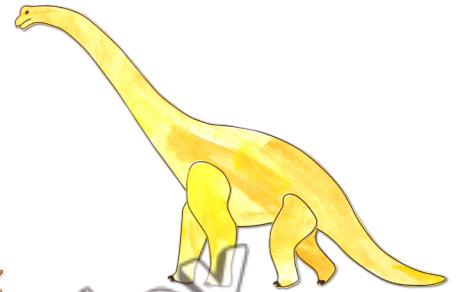

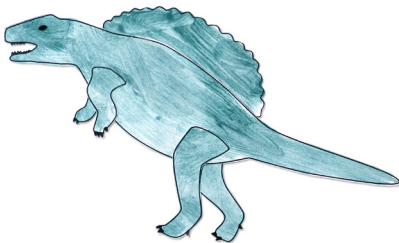

HOW TO DO IT

Color-and-Collage - Dinosaurs

1



Print out the template of your choice and color it in according to your own scheme. We recommend mixing wallpaper paste into water-based or tempera paints in several colors.

2



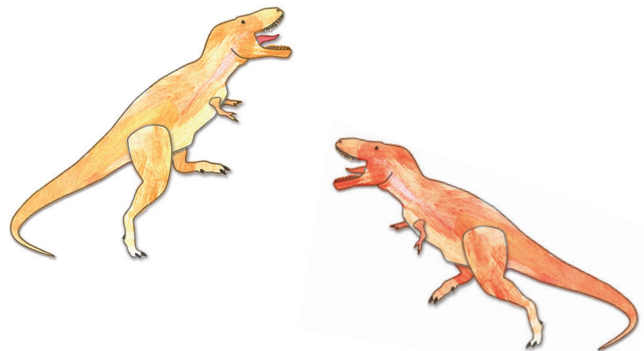
Once everything has dried, cut out all the pieces and arrange them together. The exact body and leg positions can be recreated using the template.

Collage the pieces together by glueing them onto a sheet of paper. If you like, you can first design a fitting Age of Reptiles background!

There are two templates for each dinosaur (one looking to the right and one to the left), so that you can make a large mural or a collaborative poster.
