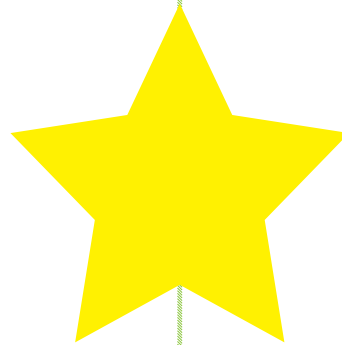


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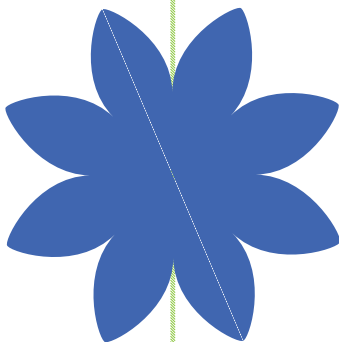


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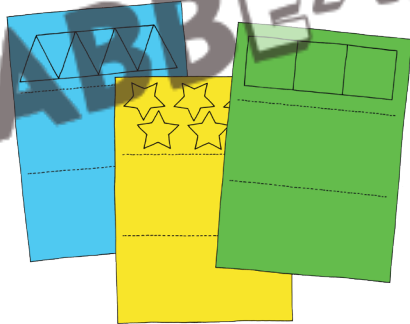


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HOW TO MAKE IT

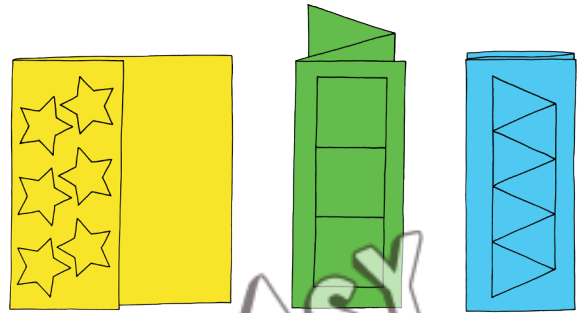
Sewn Garlands

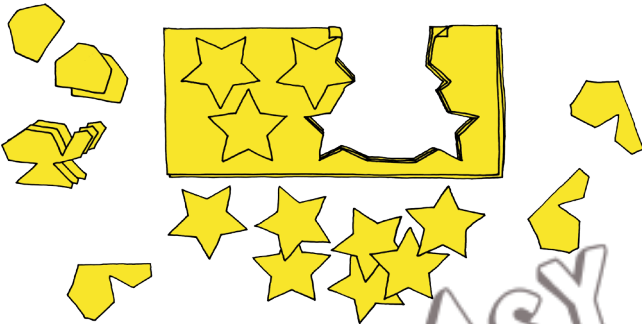
Print out your chosen shapes in the sizes you like on colored printing paper.

2



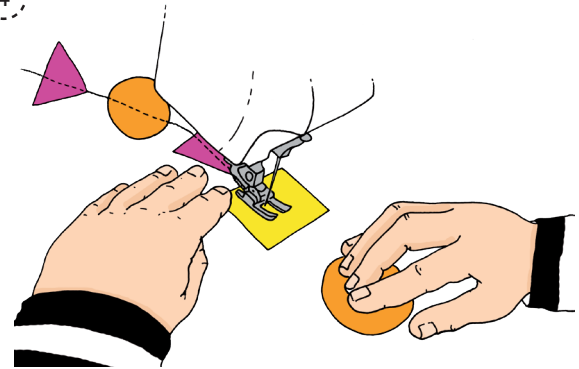
Fold the templates along the dotted lines to make an accordion fold.

3



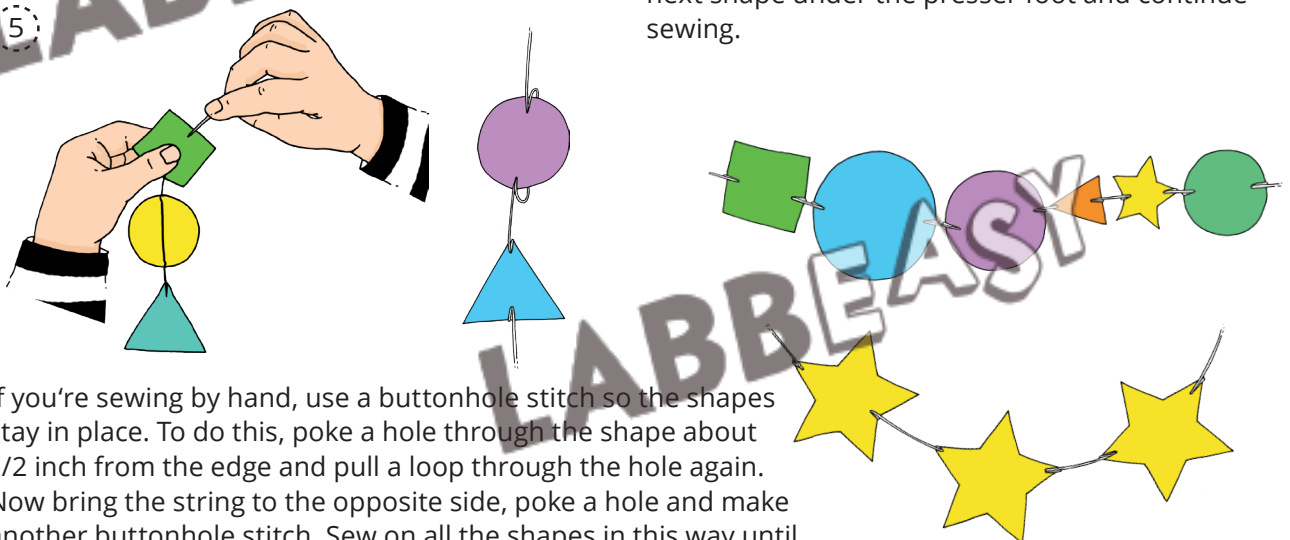
Cut out the individual shapes through all layers.

Sew the shapes together in any order with a sewing machine. You should leave about an inch between the shapes. Carefully slide the next shape under the presser foot and continue sewing.

If you're sewing by hand, use a buttonhole stitch so the shapes stay in place. To do this, poke a hole through the shape about 1/2 inch from the edge and pull a loop through the hole again. Now bring the string to the opposite side, poke a hole and make another buttonhole stitch. Sew on all the shapes in this way until the garland is the length you want.

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
