HOW TO MAKE IT

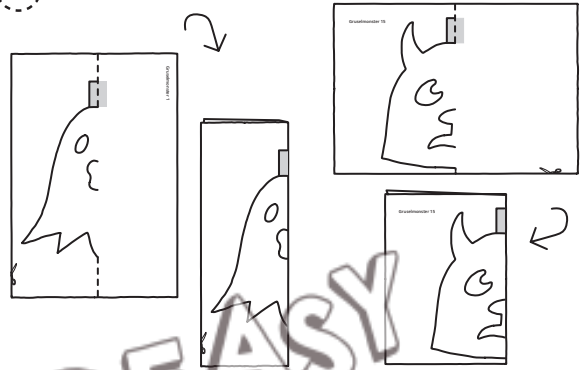

1



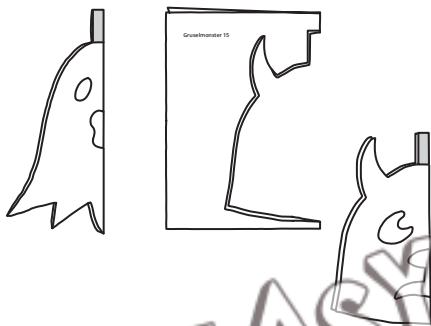
Print out the templates you want on printing paper and cut along the solid line. Some templates are in landscape format and some in portrait.

2



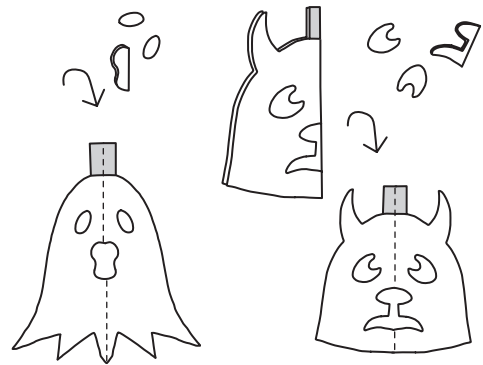
Fold the template in half along the dotted line, either vertically or horizontally depending on the format. You should see half a monster.

3



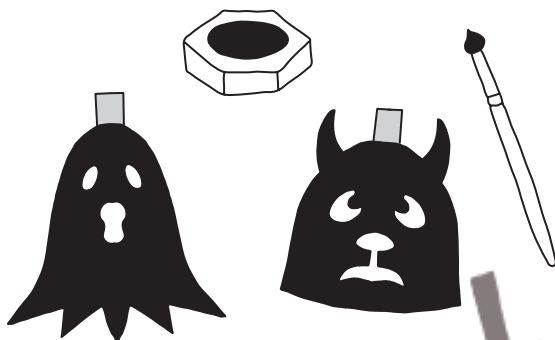
Cut out the monster completely, including the gray flap. Small crafting scissors work best.

4



Carefully cut out the eyes, nose, mouth, teeth, etc. Unfold the monster and smooth it out.

5



Decorate the monsters how you like. They can be black, white or colorful. Use paint, crayons, colored pencils or markers.

6



Fold the gray flaps back. Hang the monster on a string and tape the flap to the back of the monster.
