HOW TO DO IT

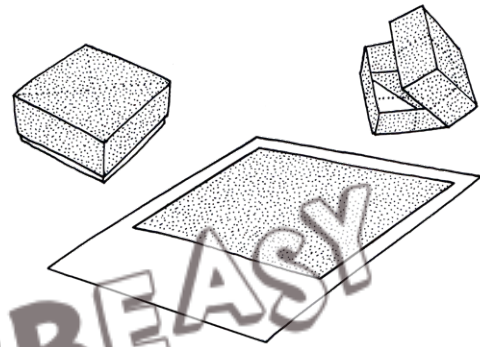
Origami Boxes

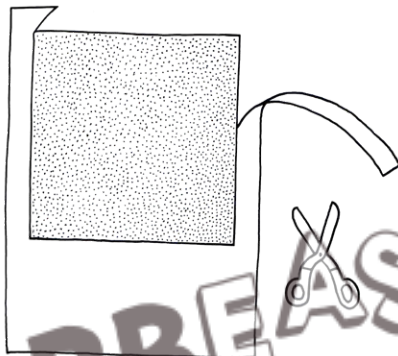
Choose the desired box instructions and print them if you wish. Then select a patterned sheet and print it out.

2



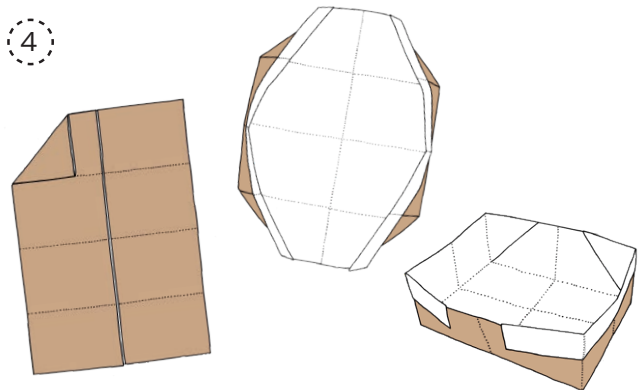
For boxes that require square paper, print out a square patterned sheet. For boxes that require rectangular paper, a rectangular patterned sheet is printed out.

Cut out the patterned part of the sheet along the outside edges.

You can now start folding! In these instructions, we indicate the patterned side of the paper with color.

TIPS

1

The patterned sheets can also be printed on colored paper or colored in with pencils.

If you're a practiced origami master, you can use any other paper at the same size, such as wrapping paper, newspaper, etc.

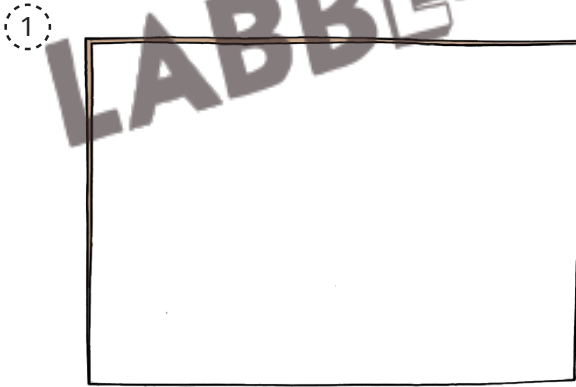
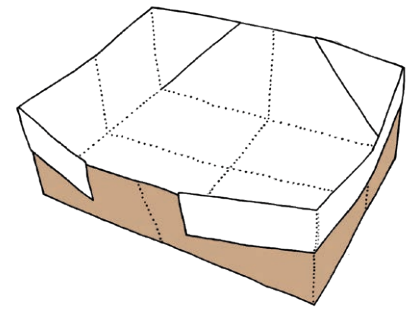
As with all origami folding: The more accurate the folds, the better the result.

It's really important to score the edges (ideally with your fingernail). New edges should be scored again after each step.

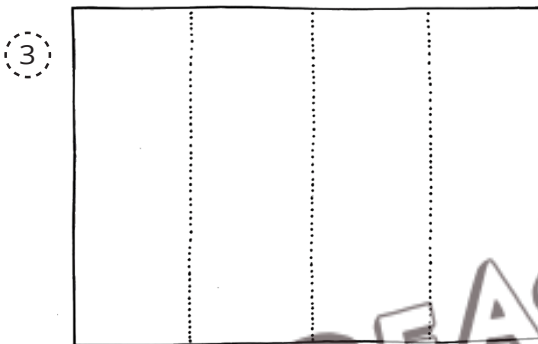
Odds and Ends Box



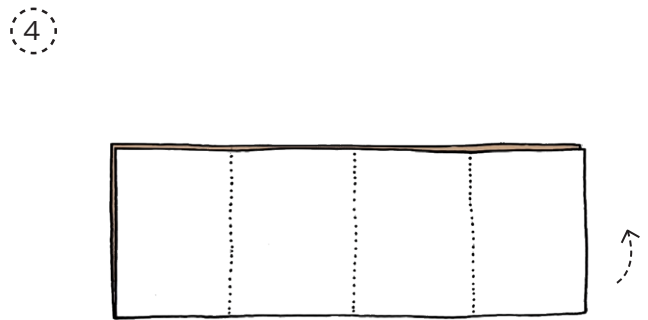
Fold a rectangular sheet in half.



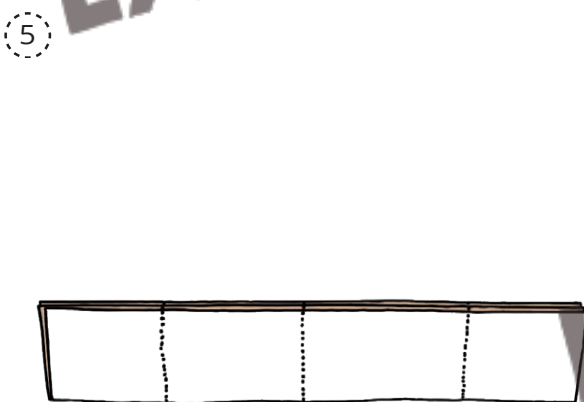
Fold the sheet in half again.



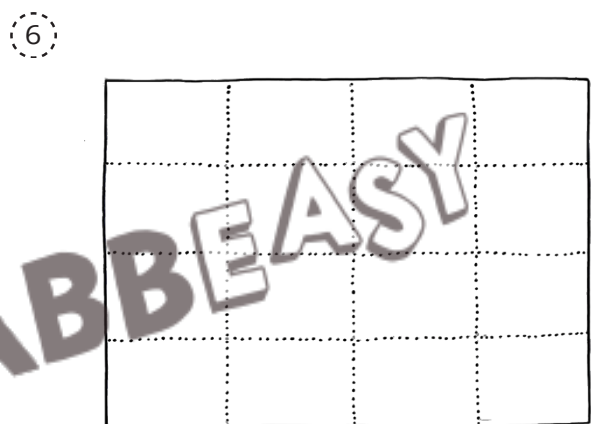
Completely unfold the sheet and turn it 90 °.



Fold the sheet in half again.

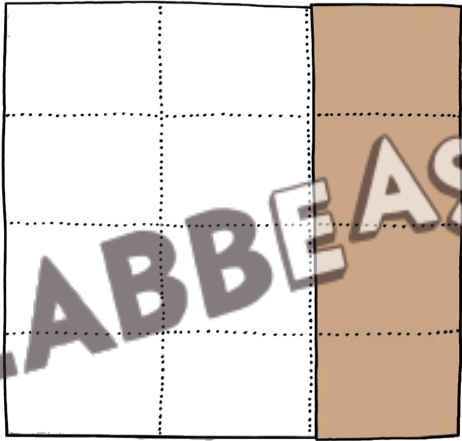


And fold the sheet in half once more.



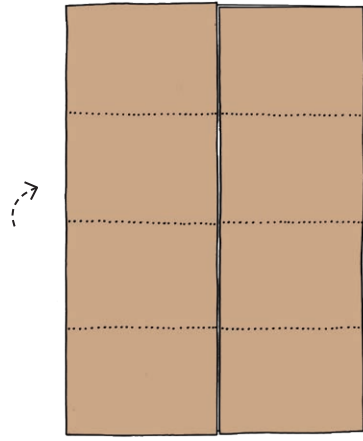
Unfold the sheet and smooth it flat with your hand.

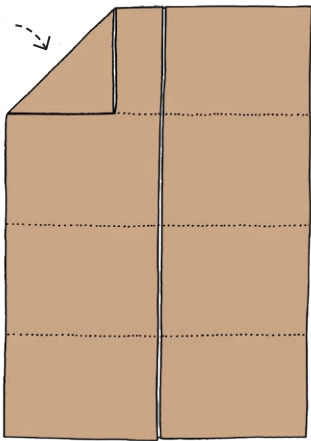
Fold the right-hand strip inwards.

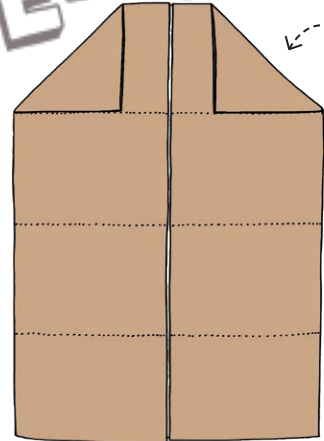
Fold the left-hand strip inwards.

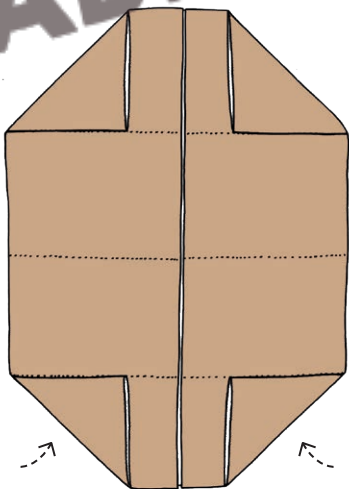
Fold down the top left corner to meet the upper fold line.

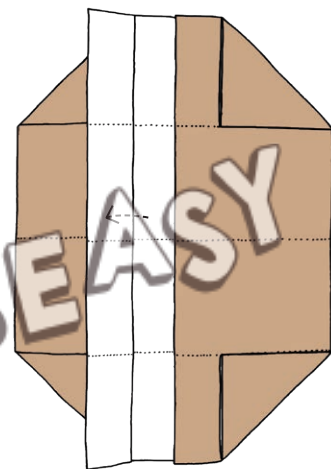
Fold down the top right corner to meet the upper fold line.

Fold both bottom corners in the same way.

Fold the left inner edge outwards.
