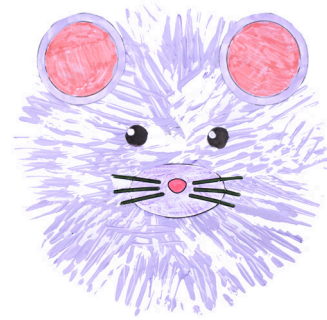
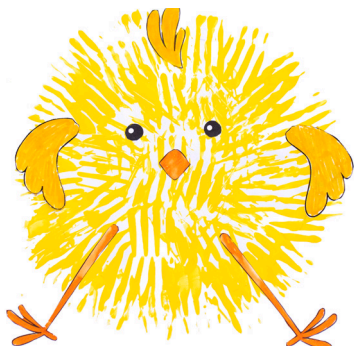

HOW TO DO IT

Fork-Print Animals

1



Print out the desired template and separate the fork-printing circle from the rest of the sheet, cutting along the dotted line.

2



Paint the eyes, ears, and snout, and then cut them out.

3



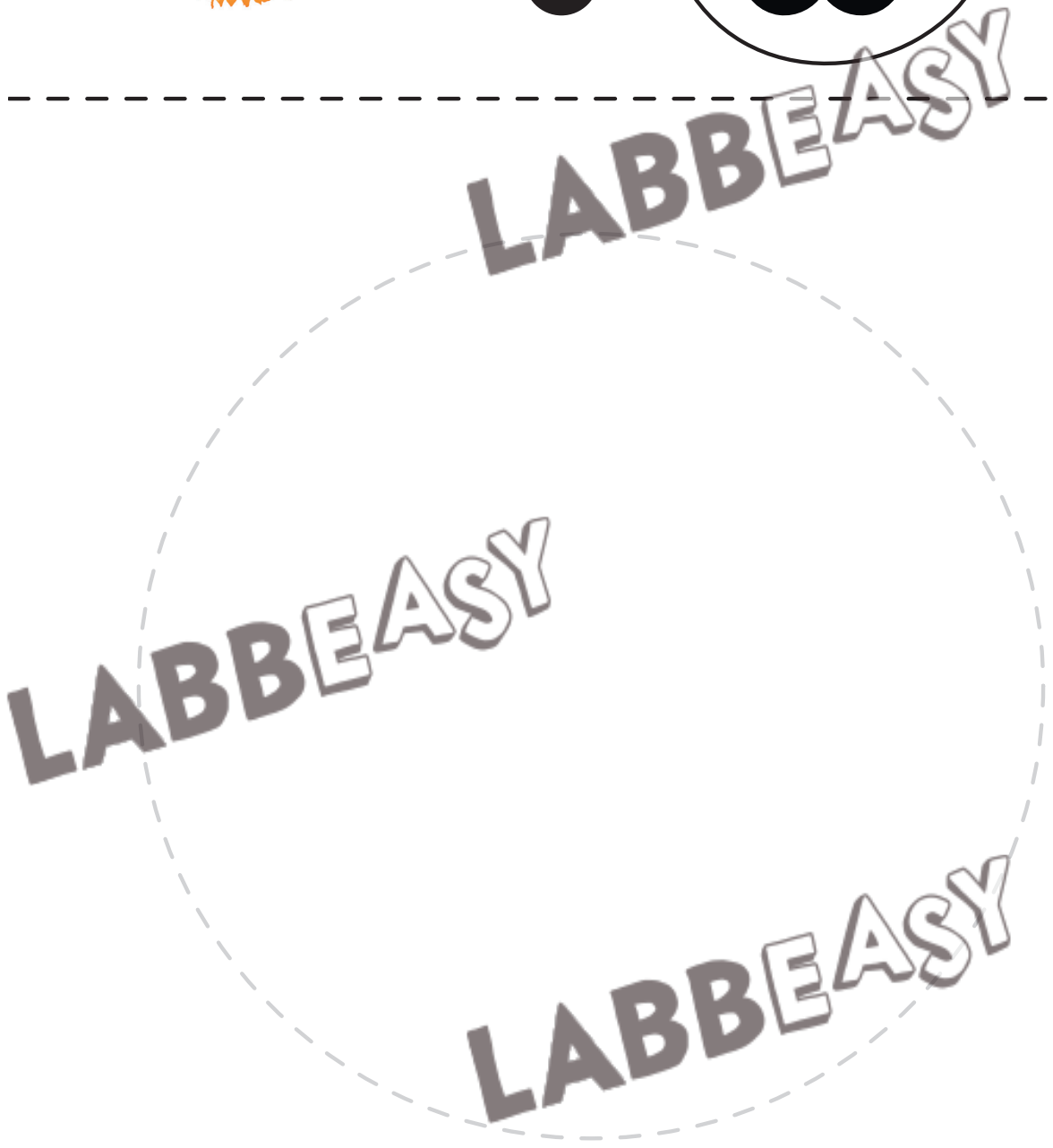
Dip a fork into finger or tempera paint and press it down onto the circular printing area so that the paint radiates outwards from the middle.

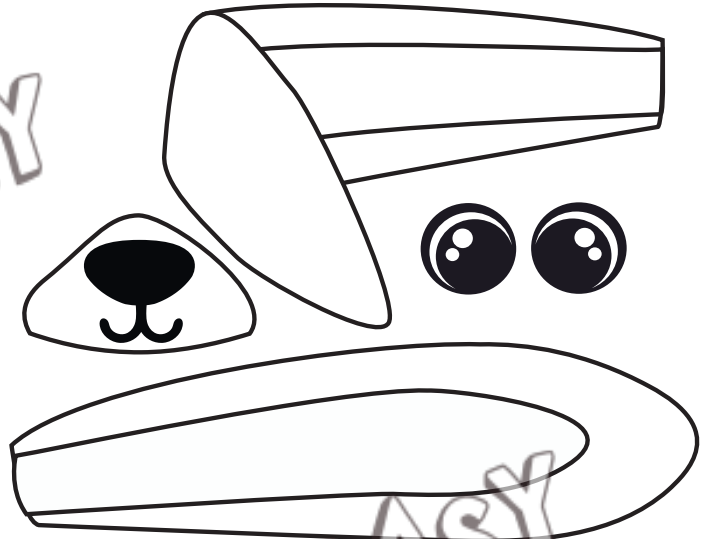


Glue the eyes, ears, and snout onto the printed circle... AWESOME!
