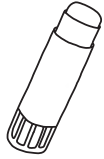

## INSTRUCTIONS

# Paper Springs

1



Take two strips of paper and glue the ends together as pictured. Now you can start folding.

2



Fold the bottom green strip up over the orange strip.

3



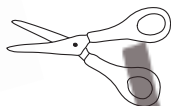
Fold the orange strip over the green strip from right to left.

4



Continue folding alternately until only two small ends are left.

5



Glue the two ends together and cut off any excess paper.

6



For extra long paper springs, glue several of them together.

## FROG



### HOW TO MAKE IT

1. Make four paper springs out of green paper.
2. Cover a toilet paper roll with green construction paper.
3. Draw the frog's face and two feet on green construction paper and cut them out.
4. Glue the frog's face to the top of the toilet paper roll.
5. Glue the paper springs to the toilet paper roll as the arms and legs.
6. Glue the feet on the legs.

## CROCODILE



### HOW TO MAKE IT

1. Make a long paper spring out of green paper.
2. Draw the crocodile's head and tail on green construction paper and cut them out.
3. Glue both parts to each end of the paper spring.

## OWL



### HOW TO MAKE IT

1. Draw an owl on cardboard and cut it out.
2. Cut out the eyes and beak from construction paper and glue them on the owl.
3. Make a small paper spring and glue it on as well.

## BUG



### HOW TO MAKE IT

1. Draw a bug with wings on cardboard and cut it out.
2. Cut out the antennae, eyes and spots from construction paper and glue them on the bug.
3. Make a red paper spring and glue it on as well.
