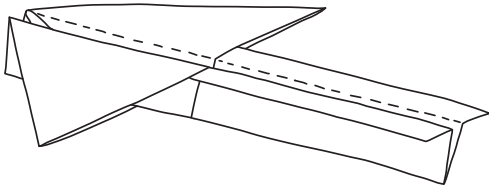

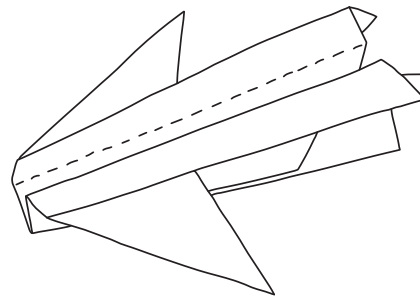

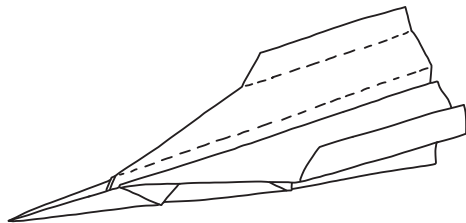

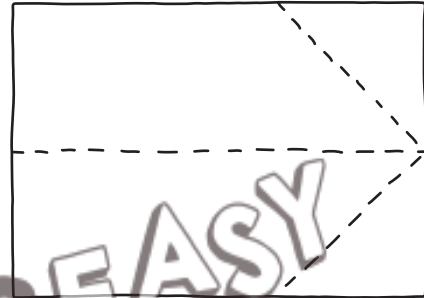

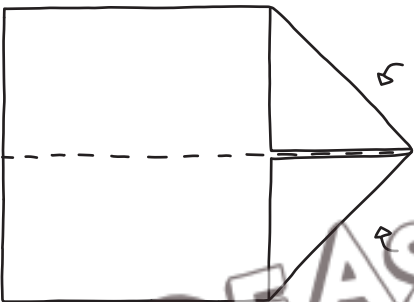
Fold the sheet in half lengthwise and then unfold it again.

②



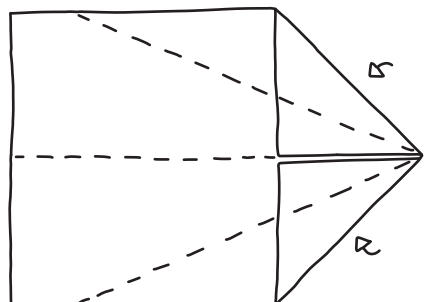
Fold the top right and bottom right corners to the center line.

③



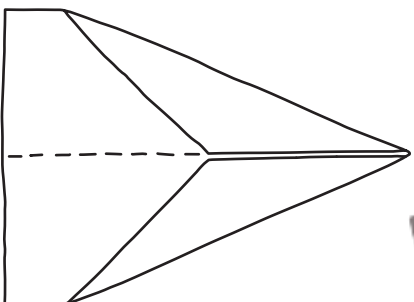
This will give you a point. Always score the folded edges with your fingernail.

Fold the top right and and bottom right corners to the middle line once more.

⑤

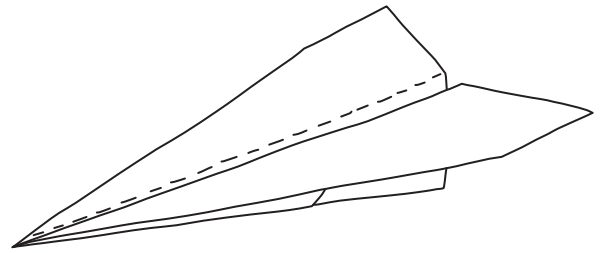


This will give you a long point.

⑥

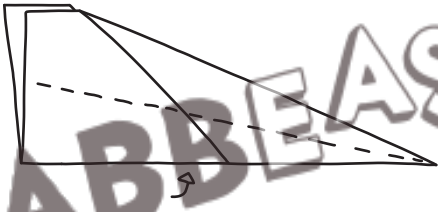


Turn the plane over.



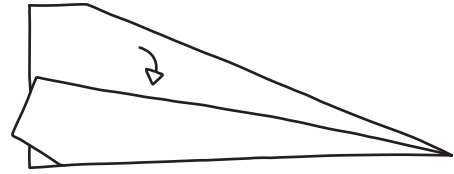

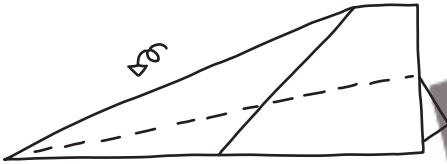
Fold the plane together in the middle.

Carefully fold the wing that's on top down to meet the bottom edge.

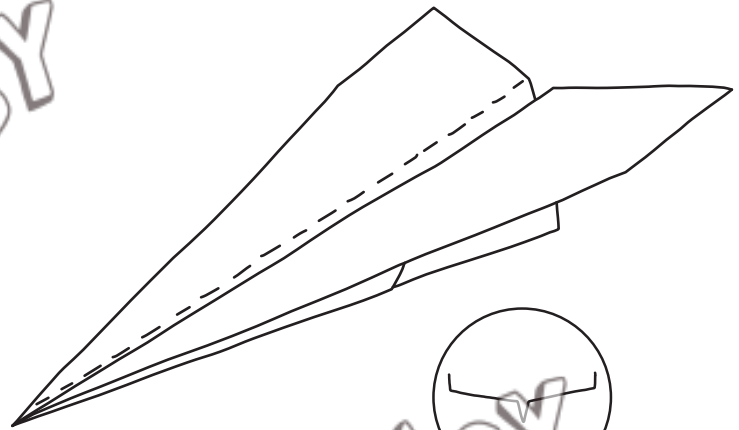


Fold down the second wing to meet the bottom edge just like you did with the other one.
