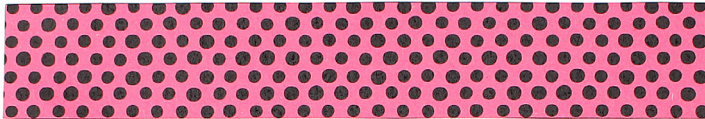

# Paper Beads

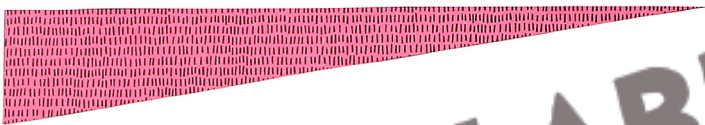
You can make many different kinds of paper beads, depending on the shape of the paper. For beginners, we recommend the rectangular templates. The pointed templates require a little practice.

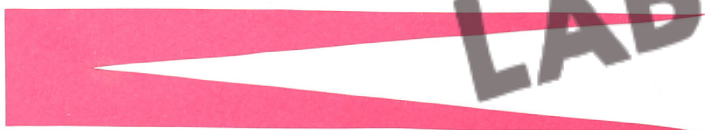

## HOW TO MAKE IT

# Rolling Paper Beads

1



For the paper beads, you'll need: printing paper, a wooden skewer, scissors, a glue stick and string.

2



Print out your chosen templates and cut them out. If you like, you can color or paint the templates beforehand.

3



Roll the cut out paper strip as tightly and as straight as possible onto the wooden skewer. Be sure the patterned side is facing out.

4



Carefully apply glue to the last 1/2 in (1-2 cm) of the strip and roll it up, pressing firmly.

5



Once the glue has dried, carefully slide the bead off of the skewer and thread the string through it.

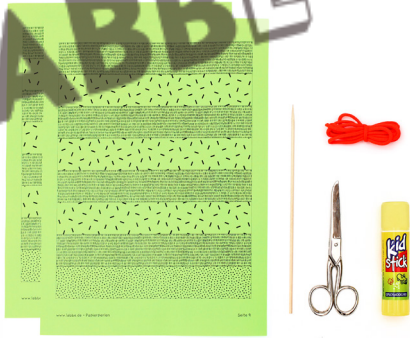
### TIP

The shapes can also be used as a template to cut newspaper or magazines. This creates cool, individual paper beads!

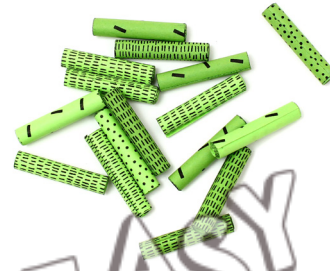
# Cactus Necklace

1



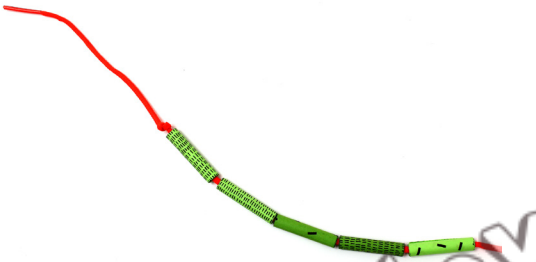
To make the cactus necklace, you'll need: 2 copies of page 10 printed on green printing paper, a wooden skewer, scissors, a glue stick and string.

2



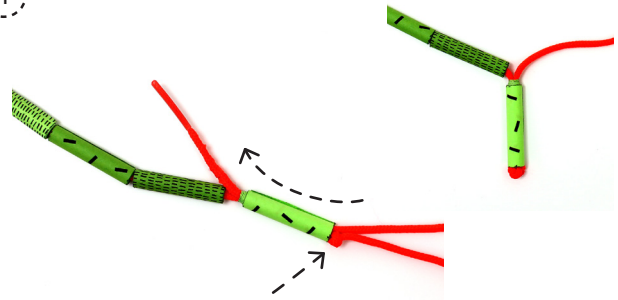
Cut out all the templates. Roll them into paper beads according to the instructions, gluing them at the end, and let them dry.

3



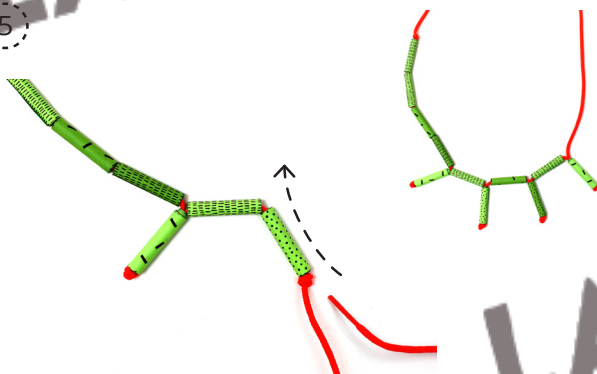
Make a knot on one end of the string so the beads don't fall off. Thread the string through the first 5 beads.

4



Tie another knot just after the 5th bead and thread the string back through the 5th bead.

5



Thread the string through two more beads, tie a knot and thread the string back through the last bead. Repeat this step two more times.

6



Now thread the string through the remaining four beads and close the necklace with a knot. Your cactus necklace is complete!
