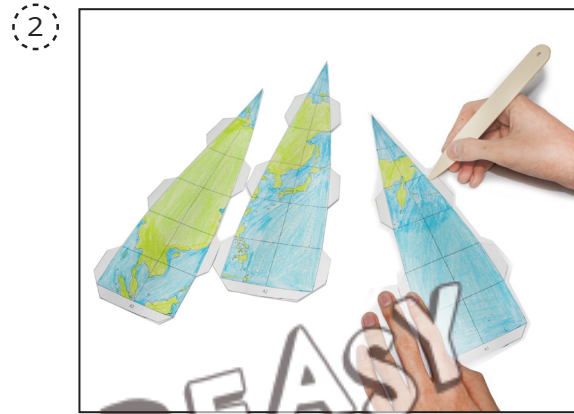

HOW TO DO IT

Large Paper Globe



Print the templates out on heavy white printing paper and color them in. You can use an atlas as a guide. Carefully cut out all the parts.



Score the edges of the glueing tabs and fold them back.



Stick the first A segment to the support ring. Continue attaching the following A segments to form a hemisphere. Stick together the other hemisphere using the B segments.



Stick four of the support elements together to form a ring and glue one ring to each hemisphere using the glueing tabs.



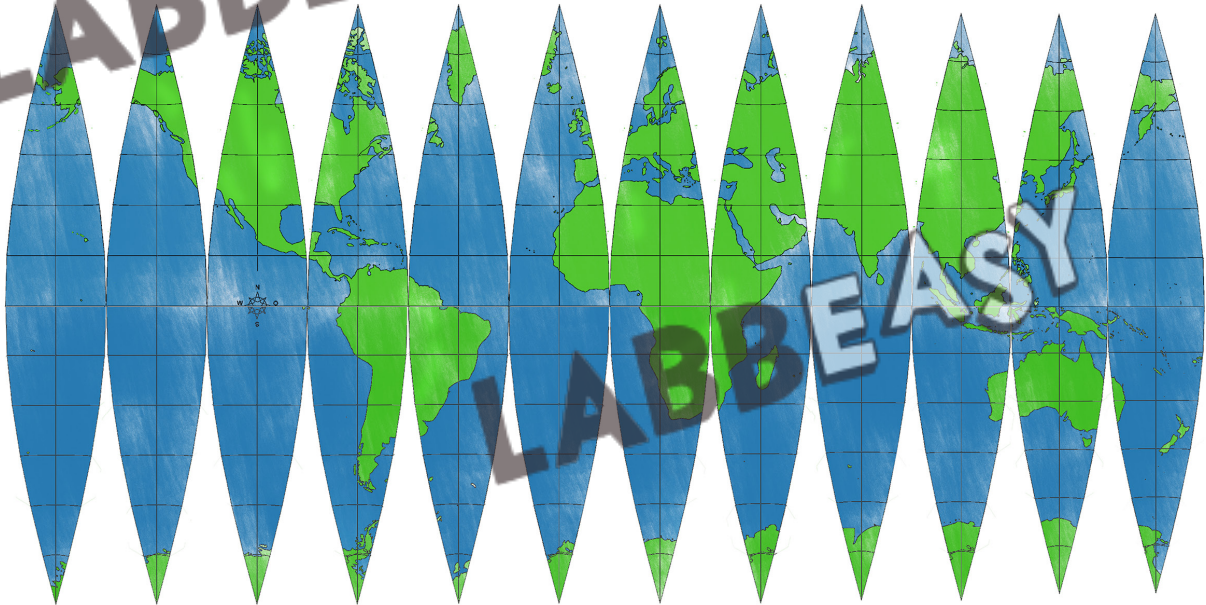
Thread a string through the top of the upper hemisphere, A. You'll use this to hang up your finished globe.



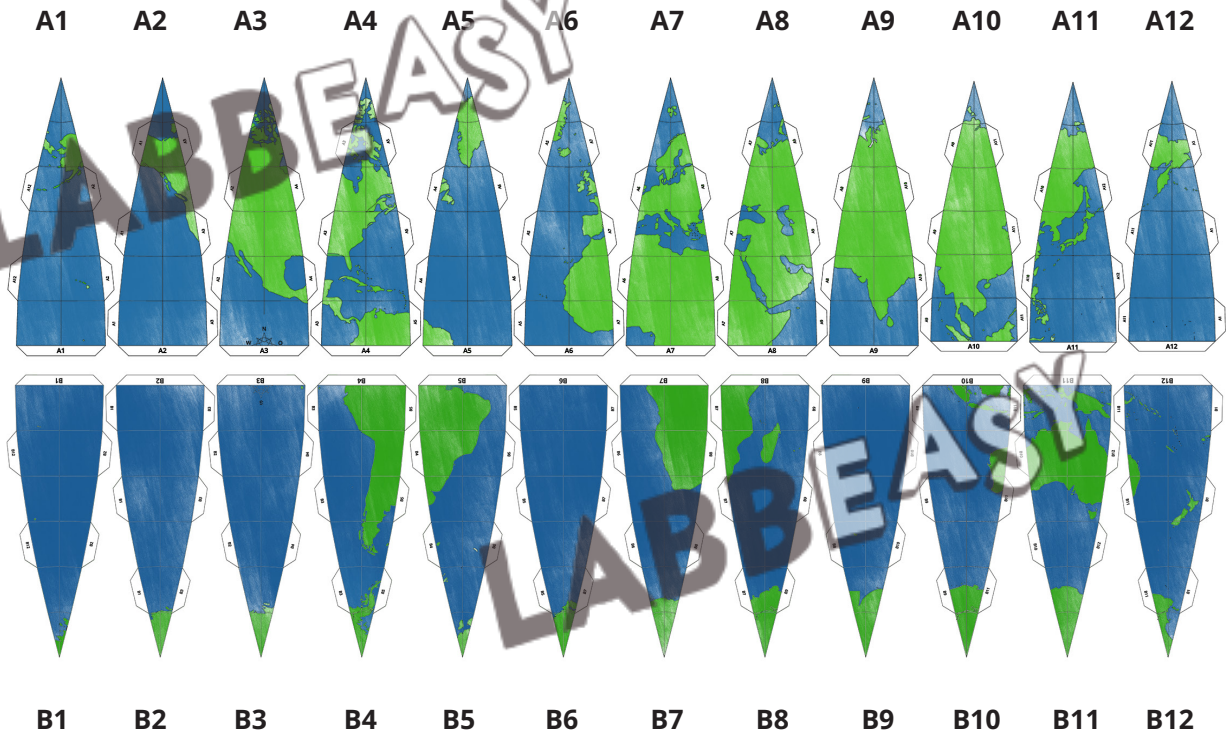
Finally, stick the two hemispheres together to form your large globe... AWESOME!!!
