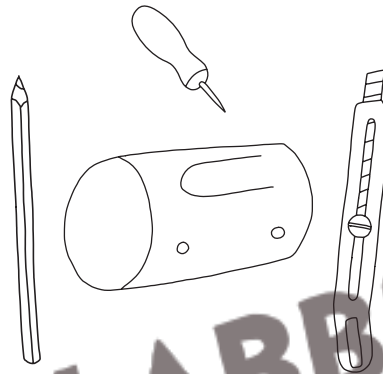
Cardboard Roll Cars

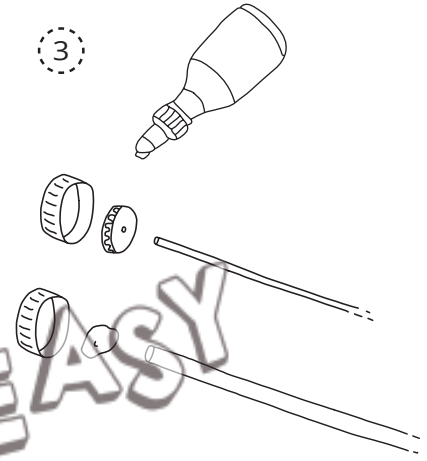
Everything you need to make toilet paper roll cars is pictured here. In addition, you'll need: scissors, a craft knife, glue, modeling clay, acrylic paint, a paintbrush, a stapler and a pin-prick needle.

Draw the shapes you want on the toilet paper roll and cut them out with a craft knife or with the help of a pin-prick needle and scissors.

For the wheels, you can use bottle caps or cardboard circles. You can connect them with wooden skewers, straws or modeling clay.

STICKERS



Once dry, you can design the toilet paper rolls with stickers (page 19).

ROAD SYSTEMS



Print out your chosen road templates (pages 12-17) on heavy printing paper, cut them out and glue them together to form a road system. If you like, you can also paint the roads.

ROAD SIGNS



Print out the road signs (page 18) and glue them to the toilet paper rolls or simply draw them on.

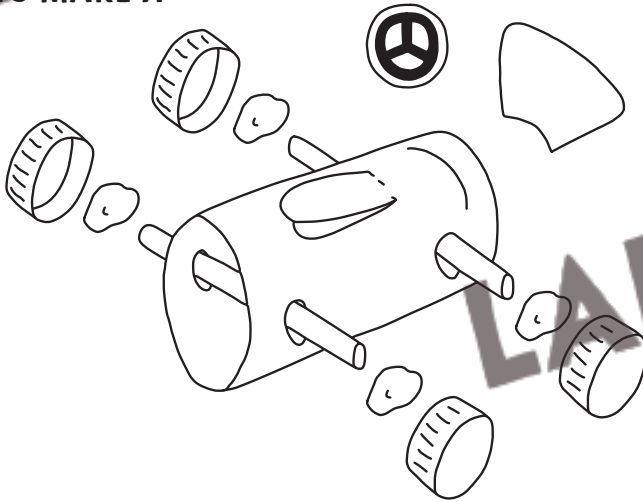
