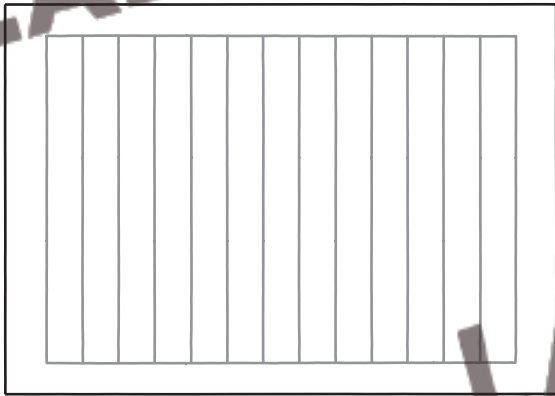

HOW TO DO IT

Woven Christmas Trees

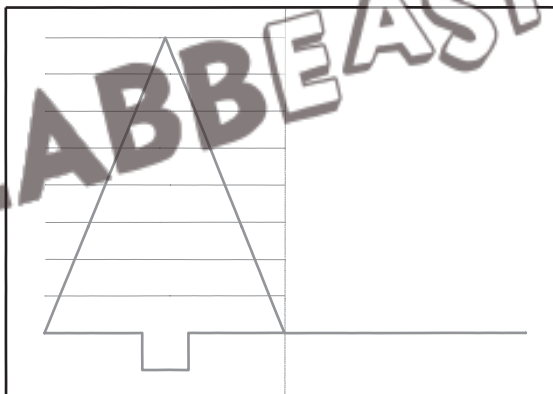
Print the sheet with the strips on colored paper. Alternatively you can print the sheet on white paper and then color it in.

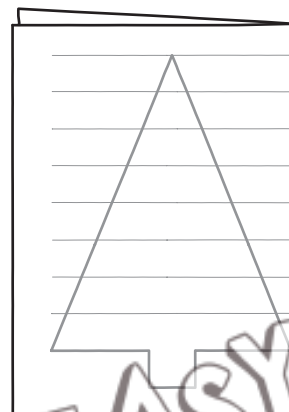
Cut out the frame and then the individual strips.

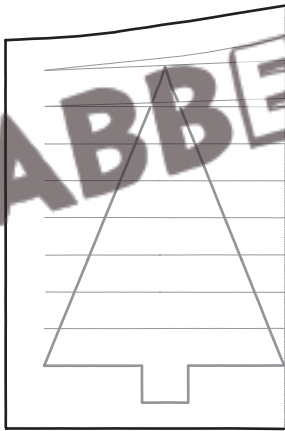
Print out the desired motif sheet on colored or white paper.

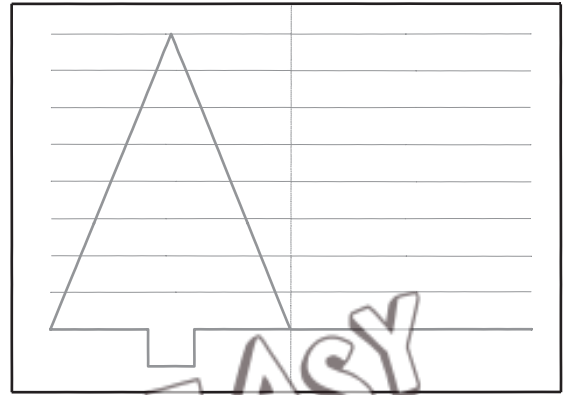


Fold the sheet in the middle.

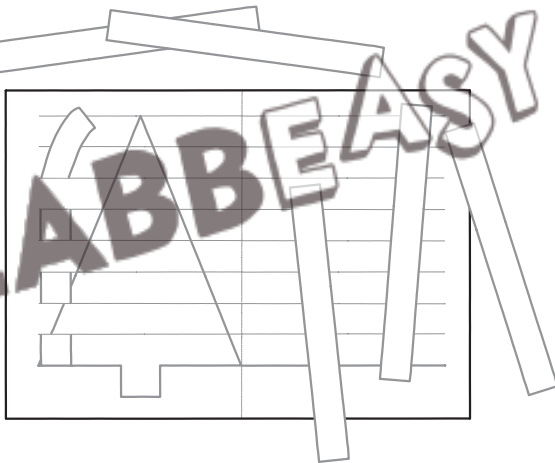

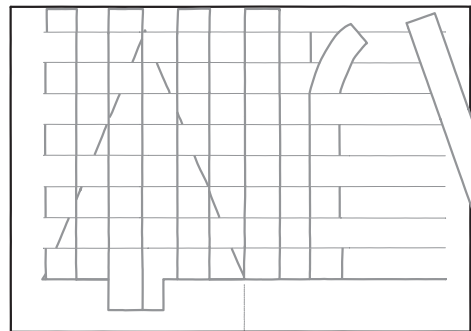
Cut along each line up to the end. Don't cut through the lower part with the trunk.

Unfold the sheet once more. Now you have a weaving mat.

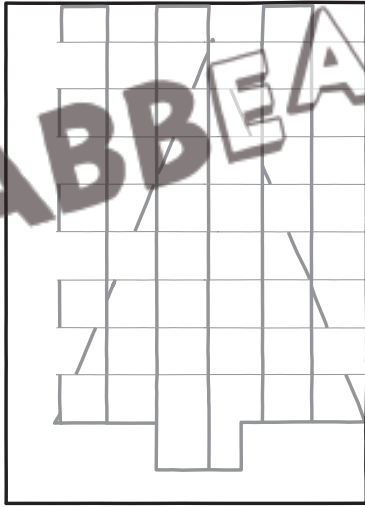

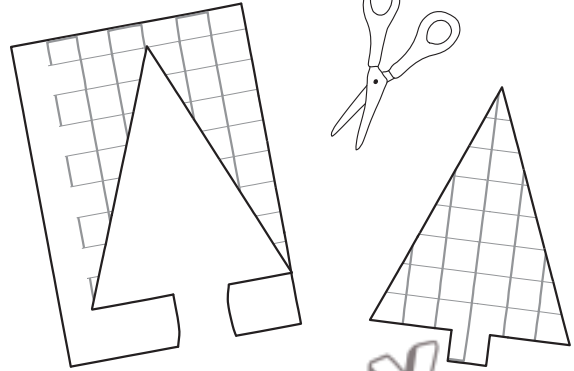
To begin with, weave in a strip along the centre and then slide it to the far left. Stick it to the mat top and bottom with a glue stick so it stays in place.

Weave in the other strips in the same way until the mat is full.

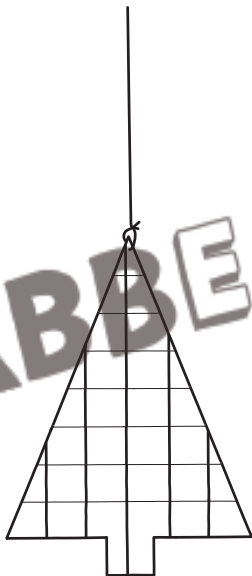

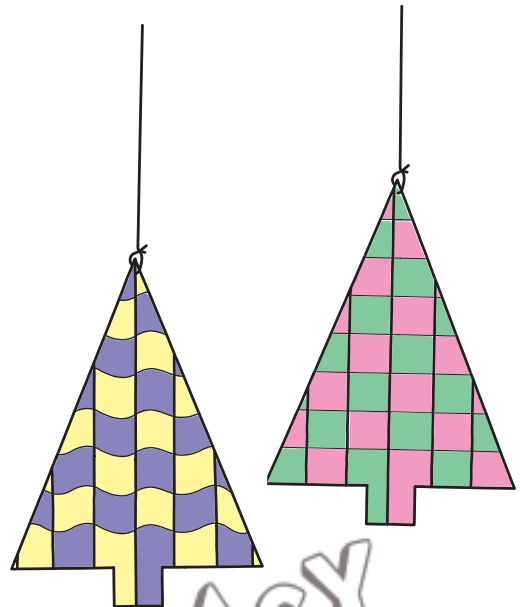
Daub the reverse of the weaving mat with glue and fold the mat together. Put a piece of paper over the mat and then rub it flat with your fist.

Cut out the Christmas tree all the way along the outer edge.

Using a needle, run a thin thread through the tip of the tree so you can hang it up.

There are two variations of the woven Christmas tree: One motif with straight lines and one with wavy lines. Both trees come in two sizes.
