


## HOW TO DO IT Hidden Object Pacorama - Fall Scene

You can make the hidden object fall picture in three different ways. All three versions are suitable for individual, partner, and group work.

## HIDDEN OBJECT PANORAMA - FALL SCENE - COLOR IN

Kids can simply use colored pencils or felt-tip pens to color in the panorama picture. Even younger children can do this, thereby training their stamina and fine motor skills.



Print out pages 5 to 8 and cut out the templates along the dotted lines.



Glue the pages together using the glueing panels to form a panoramic picture, and color it in as desired with colored pencils or felt-tip pens.

## CREATIVE HIDDEN OBJECT PANORAMA - FALL SCENE

For the creative hidden object fall panorama, children draw their own motifs on the picture. This not only trains their fine motor skills, but also stimulates their imagination and promotes creativity.



Print out pages 9 to 12 and cut out the templates along the dotted lines. Glue the pages together using the glueing panels to form a panoramic picture, and draw on your own motifs using colored pencils or felt-tip pens.
