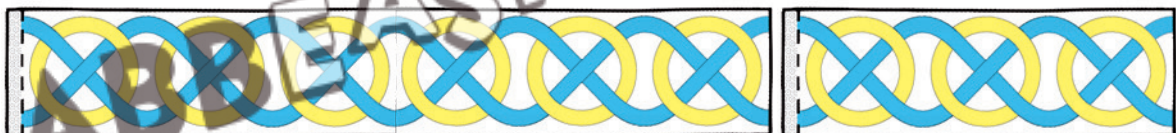

Choose the border pattern you like and color it. Always be sure to use the same color for one continuous 'rope'.

Cut out the borders along the solid lines, making sure to include the gluing tabs.

Glue the individual strips together using the gluing tabs separated by the dotted line to form a border. The more strips, the longer the border will be.
