## HOW TO DO IT

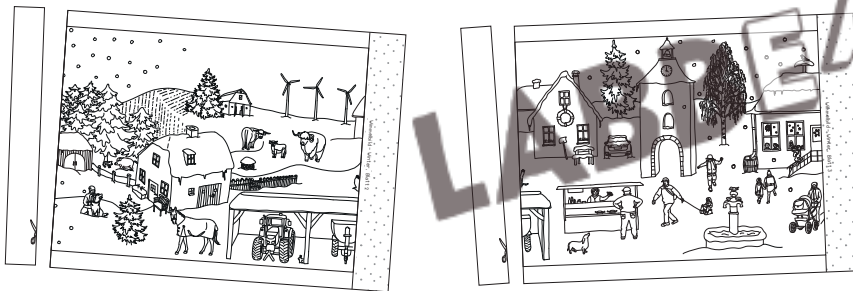
### Hidden Object Panorama - Winter Scene

You can make the hidden object winter picture in three different ways. All three versions are suitable for individual, partner, and group work.

#### HIDDEN OBJECT PANORAMA - WINTER SCENE - COLOR IN

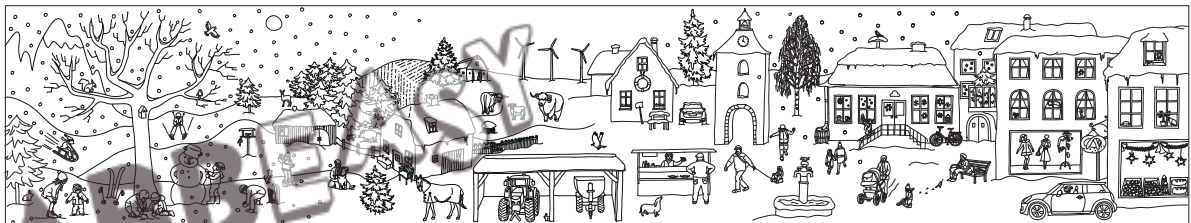
Kids can simply use colored pencils or felt-tip pens to color in the panorama picture. Even younger children can do this, thereby training their stamina and fine motor skills.

Print out pages 5 to 8 and cut out the templates along the dotted lines.

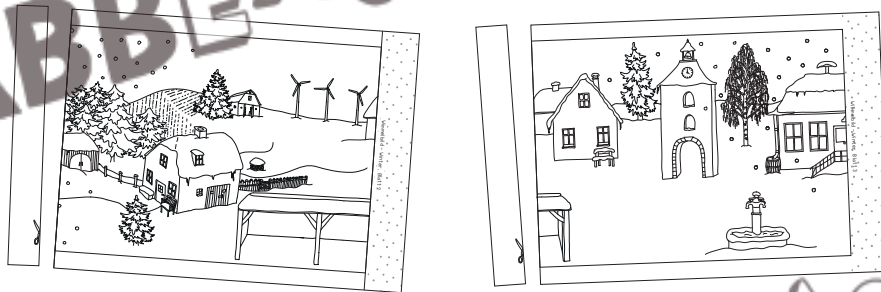


Glue the pages together using the glueing panels to form a panoramic picture, and color it in as desired with colored pencils or felt-tip pens.

## HIDDEN OBJECT PANORAMA - WINTER SCENE - COLOR, CUT, AND STICK

The cut-and-stick panorama is first colored in. Then children cut out motifs from the sticker sheet, glue them onto the panorama and color them in. In the process, they get to develop their cutting and glueing technique.

Print out pages 9 to 12 and cut out the templates along the dotted lines.

Glue the pages together using the glueing panels to form a panoramic picture, and color it in as desired with colored pencils or felt-tip pens. Cut out the motifs from the sticker sheet, glue them onto the picture and color them in.

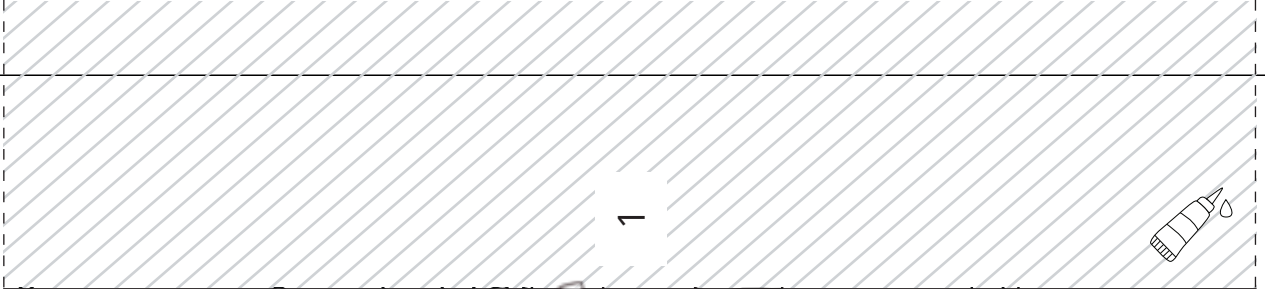
## CREATIVE HIDDEN OBJECT PANORAMA - WINTER SCENE

For the creative hidden object winter panorama, children draw their own motifs on the picture. This not only trains their fine motor skills, but also stimulates their imagination and promotes creativity.



Print out pages 9 to 12 and cut out the templates along the dotted lines. Glue the pages together using the glueing panels to form a panoramic picture, and draw on your own motifs using colored pencils or felt-tip pens.
