## HOW TO MAKE IT

# Crown I

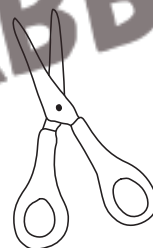
### MATERIALS

1 paper plate, scissors,  
acrylic paint or watercolors,  
paintbrush, cup of water



①

Draw a crown on the paper plate with a pencil and paint the plate.



②

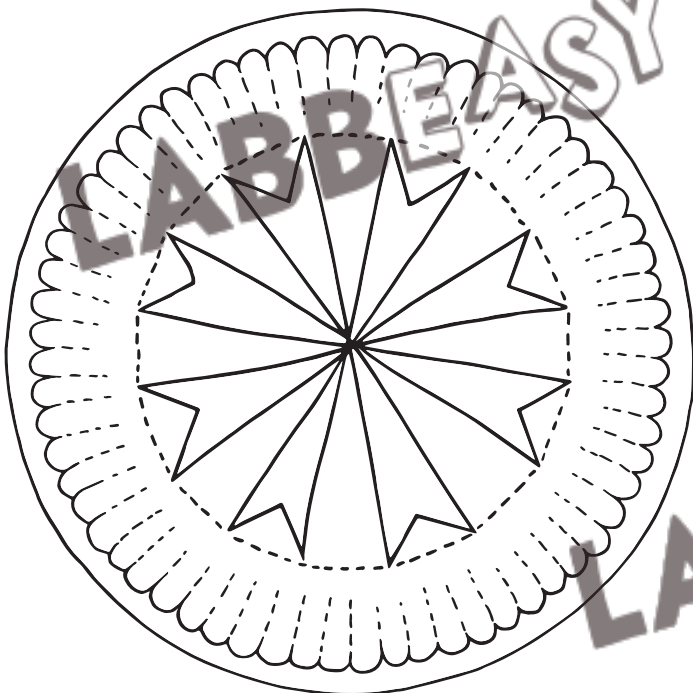
Once dry, cut out the crown and fold it upwards.

## HOW TO MAKE IT

# Crown II

### MATERIALS

1 paper plate, scissors,  
acrylic paint or watercolors,  
paintbrush, cup of water,  
gemstones

Paint the paper plate with gold paint on both sides.

②

Once dry, draw the spikes with a pencil, cut them out, fold them upwards and glue on the gemstones.
