HOW TO DO IT

HANDPRINTS

PAINT




Only use finger paints! They're easy to wash off of hands, objects, and textiles.


CARD & PAPER



You can make handprints on all common types of paper and card. Since the paint is quite wet, thinner papers will crinkle a bit. Therefore, using card or heavier paper works better.

APPLYING THE PAINT





Fingerpaints are applied with your fingers or a paintbrush. It doesn't make much difference if the paint is applied thickly or thinly.

To get a consistent, strong handprint you should press the painted hand down with your other, clean one. This will help you avoid leaving bare patches in the print.

NEXT STEPS

When your handprints are dry you can cut them out, draw on, and stick things to them.
